1). To Register as a New Member.

1. Click on 'Register / Login' on the Top Menu Bar.
2. Click 'New Registration of Private Garden' or 'New Registration of Commercial Garden' button.
3. The Registration Form will appear. Type in your details. Please ensure all the boxes marked by an asterisk are filled in.
4. Type in your Username; this will be your identity on the website and is the only detail that you will not be able to change once registered. Please ensure that your username is 6-12 letters long and in lower case letters, and that it bears no resemblance to your real name, house name etc. Keep a record of this.
5. Type in a Password, again in 6-12 lower case letters. Please keep a record of this.
6. Read our terms and conditions and check the box if you agree to them.
7. Click the Register button at bottom of form.
8. The form will then exit and you will be asked to log-in with your username and password, in order to make sure these are functioning correctly.
9. The form will now return with your previously entered details displayed and also with additional boxes for Garden title and Garden description.
10. Give your Garden a title. Then type in your garden details, either directly onto the page, or copy and paste from your prepared text. Please do not refer to peoples' names in your description, nor give any indication of your age, daily movements, or facts such as that you live on your own. Please see 'Material unsuitable for displaying on Excuse The Weeds', below, for material which we deem unsuitable for this website.
11. Click the 'Update' button. You are now registered and until you decide to de-register (see 'Member De-registration' below).
12. You can now proceed to the facility for entering your garden photographs if you wish, by clicking on the 'Upload Images' link just above the registration form. Section 4 below will guide

you through the image upload procedure. Alternatively you can log out and add your garden photos at a later date.

2). Member De-registration

To de-register as a member of Excuse The Weeds, please log-in and then click the 'Inactivate Account' button at the bottom of the registration page. A window will appear saying 'Are you sure you wish to de-register. Click 'Yes'. You will be sent a confirmation e-mail. If for any reason you are de-registered in error, please contact us.

3). Material unsuitable for displaying on Excuse The Weeds

We reserve the right to remove any entry containing photographic or written material that we deem unsuitable for the website (see items (a) to (e) below), or which may compromise the integrity of the website.

- (a). Any material, pictorial or written that we deem as offensive, inflammatory or in breach of English Law.
- (b). Any plant material which is termed as illegal by British Law.
- (c). Images of people or children.
- (d). Imagery unrelated to the context of this website.
- (e). Material of an advertising nature, for example: banners, links, and advertising text and imagery, unless it has been arranged by prior agreement with BriteTec Ltd.

Should such a case occur, we will reserve the right to terminate a membership and to remove all material related to that membership.

4). To Enter your Garden Photographs.

1. Click on 'Register / Login' on the Top Menu Bar.
2. Enter your Username and Password. The registration form will appear. Click on the 'Upload Images' link above the form. A page will appear enabling you to upload your pictures.

Note. Before entering your pictures, please note that the larger the picture size in terms of megabytes, the longer the picture will take to upload. As a guideline one megabyte takes approximately one minute to upload. Please ensure that you do not upload more than 25 Megabytes of picture files at one time.

We also recommend that you take the following precautions for displaying your pictures, as a guide to maintaining the privacy of yourself, your neighbours, and also future owners of your property.

(a). We advise you not to display any items that might be considered as valuable. For example this may include statues, rare plants and pets. We cannot be held responsible if items are removed from your premises as a result of them being published online by 'Excuse the Weeds'.

(b). Please avoid displaying images of your house, or of adjoining or surrounding buildings, or parts of buildings showing potential entry points. Again we cannot be held responsible if items are removed from yours or neighbours' premises as a result of being published online by 'Excuse the Weeds'.

(c). Please avoid showing access points to your garden, via your property or via the area surrounding your garden.

3. Click on the 'Browse' button next to Image 1, and select a picture from your files. Give the picture a title and then repeat for Image 2 etc... We recommend you upload a maximum of three pictures at a time to minimise time wastage should your internet connection be interrupted for whatever reason.
4. Click the Upload button at the bottom of the form. Please wait. After a few seconds a blue progress bar will show at the bottom of the screen. When the blue section has moved all the way across, the screen should update and the pictures you loaded will then be displayed in 'thumbnail' size in the order they were selected. However, depending on the file size and number of pictures selected, the blue progress bar may reach its maximum position and then remain stationary for a few minutes until all pictures have been uploaded and resized.
5. Repeat the upload procedure as necessary.
6. Once you are satisfied you have uploaded all your pictures then click on 'Logout' above the form. This will return you to our Home page. Once we have deemed your registration and garden photographs as okay we will then activate your garden profile, which you will then be able to view. (See 'To view the Gardens' below).

5). To log-in as a member and change your registration details or garden description.

1. Click on 'Register / Login' on the Top Menu Bar.
2. Enter your login name and password. (Use the forgotten password link if necessary. You will then receive an e-mail with the details).
3. The registration form will appear.
4. Change your registration details, or garden description. To change a description, highlight and delete the text, or add or paste new text.
5. Ensure you have entered your password onto the form.
6. Click the 'Submit' button at the bottom of the form. The form will update almost instantaneously.
7. If you wish to return to the picture upload form, click on 'Upload Images' above the form.
8. Please do not forget to log out after you have finished changing your details.

6). To log-in as a member and change your garden pictures.

1. Click on 'Register / Login' on the Top Menu Bar.
2. Enter your login name and password.
3. The registration form will appear.
4. Click on 'Upload Images' above the form.
5. The picture upload form will appear, with thumbnails representing your pictures.
6. Firstly delete all the pictures you wish to replace. Clicking on the 'Delete' button next to a picture will appear to delete that picture almost instantaneously, but please wait a few seconds for a picture to delete fully before deleting another one.
7. Add pictures as described in 'To Enter your Garden Photographs' above.
8. Change the titles of your pictures as necessary.
9. Click Upload at the bottom of the form and allow for the pictures to upload. As mentioned before this will take time depending on the number of pictures and the size of each picture.
10. Please do not forget to log out after you have finished changing your pictures.

7). To view the Gardens

1. Click the 'View the Gardens' button on the home page.
2. Scroll down to 'Search Garden Profiles'.
3. Just click on the Search button on the right hand side to show all gardens. OR
4. Use the Keyword Search box and /or drop-down menus to narrow the search criteria, then click on the Search button. A search results page will then be displayed.
5. Scroll down to the particular garden you wish to view, and click on the Garden Name.
6. The profile page for that particular garden will appear. Thumbnail images of the pictures are located beneath the write-up for each garden together with one large view.
7. If you move your mouse over a thumbnail without clicking, then that picture will appear as the large view.
8. The thumbnails will scroll up and down if you place your mouse on the arrows without clicking.
9. If you left-click on a thumbnail an even larger view will appear in a separate window. Left-click this image to make it disappear.
10. To return to your search results page click on 'Back to Search' at top of page.
11. To return to the Garden Profiles page and start a new search, click on 'Back to General Search' at top of page.
12. To return to our Home Page, click 'Home' on the Top Menu Bar.

8). To use the other site facilities

1. Click on 'Garden Talk' on the Top Menu Bar. A drop-down menu will appear.
2. This consists of: Latest News, Garden of the Month, Garden Articles, Our Blog (see below), and Links to other websites.
3. Click on any of these items to display the appropriate webpage.
4. If you wish to submit a garden-related article, news item or event, click on 'Contact Us' on the top menu bar, and e-mail the details. We will endeavour to display your item if the material fits within the criteria of our website.

9). To Access the Blog

A Blog is like a message-board where you can post articles, ask questions or communicate with other members.

1. Click on 'Garden Talk' on the Top Menu Bar. A drop-down menu will appear.
2. Move down to 'Our Blog' and click. The Blog homepage will appear.

10). To post your messages to the Blog.

1. On the Blog homepage click on the text link which starts "Why not add your own blog comment ..."
2. Fill in the form with your message title, message, picture (optional) and link address (optional).
3. Click on the 'Add' button at bottom of form.
4. Your message will be sent to our admin. If deemed relevant and acceptable it will then shortly appear on our blog.
